Junior Squads Manager: - *Danny Murphy*

Junior squad training for June was cancelled. July and August training will be held at Fleming Park, and on 16th September the training session will be held at Havant. Danny is hoping to enlist help from local coaches to promote these sessions and he advised that Simone Callender will be guest coach at the September session. Senior women will also be welcome to attend this session. Full details of all training sessions with dates and venues will be available on the Hampshire website.

Danny and Lance have been invited to take a junior squad to the Maltese Open competition in March/April 2011. More details to hopefully follow on this.

It is also hoped that international junior events can be incorporated next year to promote the sport. Danny asked about the possibility of fundraising by the county to support these events for between 6 and 12 players. The Chairman agreed to consider funding routes and report back to Danny with options. It was agreed though that it would be fantastic for the county if we could get a good international programme up and running.

The Chairman reported that he has made a request to the Southern Area to fund 40% of the cost for himself and Peter Powell to attend the Jersey competition. Jersey has agreed to fund some of the cost towards this trip.

The Chairman had recently awarded some of the medals at the recent Hampshire Open competition.

Peter provided an update on the last grading which was held at Fleet & Frogmore Leisure Centre. The Centre would like to hold further events, however the space there is restricted. The last grading held went really well and hopefully the August date will grow on this success.

Peter reported that he had received confirmation that the grading sheet on the website is to be updated. He is also looking at introducing a secure electronic system as an alternative payment option.

The Southern Area AGM recently held was attended by Peter and he reported that he was very disappointed as very simple questions to the Southern Area Committee from AGM delegates could not be answered.

Any Other Business

i) Jeff Hatcher reported that it is unlikely that any future senior squad sessions will be held at Calmore, this will give an opportunity for other clubs to hold the training sessions and share responsibility for hosting these events. These are to be decided by Ricky Giles, though Ricky was not present to confirm future dates.

ii) Peter Powell advised that Chris Doherty is to facilitate and coach an Instructors award for Hampshire. The cost of the event is to be £80. Peter agreed to put together a poster / flyer together to find out who would be interested in attending to get an idea of numbers as the minimum required to run this event will be 12.
