

SA AGM 21 JUNE 2020: how your club can vote club in the AGM

Dear Colleagues

Under the conditions of the SA and BJA Constitutions, all A status clubs are allowed to participate in the AGM. This email is being sent to all SA A status clubs as per the data taken April /May 2020 from The Dojo on the BJA website. (Areas are not given clubs lists by the BJA).

The report on the examination accounts by an independent accountant will not be available / posted until nearer the date Of the AGM. ALL other reports have been posted on the SA website. To read the reports

- Click on the NEWS section that advertises the AGM. Scroll down to the end of that information and the reports are listed

As you know, at an AGM clubs have the right to correct any points of the minutes from the previous year's AGM, and to ask report authors for any clarification or further information. And clubs are then asked to approve (or not or abstain) the proposals and the reports. So, although this AGM is an email format version these conditions still apply.

3. ALL corrections to the 2019 minutes and replies from report authors will be posted on website 19 June so that all clubs can see the changes / extra information.
4. Attached is the voting form for your club to record its votes (equivalent to showing a voting card at a physical AGM) . Please add your name, club name and county. Votes will not count if there is no personal name and club name. If you run more than 1 club please send in a separate voting form for each club.
5. If you wish to abstain from giving a vote on any item , please put AB in either the yes or no columns. There are 4 proposals and 10 reports to vote on.
6. **Please email me your completed form between 09.00 and 21.00 on Sunday 21 June . No forms will be invalid if received outside these hours : this mimics the card voting process.**
7. The voting results will be emailed to all clubs and posted on the website on Tues 23 June 2020.
8. The BJA requires the SA AGM report by 26 June. As the maximum length is 750 words the SA report included in the BJA's annual report will not be exactly the same as the ones presented to this AGM.

The SA Committee are fully aware of the difficulties created by the long-term impact of the pandemic on our judo family. The SAC and the sub committees are working behind the scenes to develop ways to support clubs and players over the remaining months of this lockdown and the future time of "Back to the Mat". **Thank you for continuing to support Southern Area Judo.**
